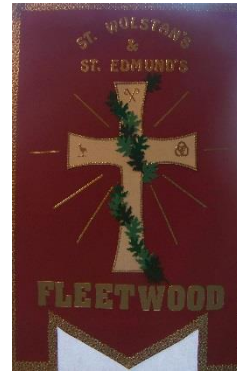


Repeats
