THE SEASON OF CHRISTMASTIDE: For most people Christmas ends at midnight on Christmas day. But for the Catholic Church, it means the celebration has just begun. Many of us Catholics, however, are not aware of this. Our rhythm of celebrating Christmas is very much along the lines of the secular celebration. We put a massive amount of effort into preparing for December 25th...then, the very next day, we feel a bit blue. "It's over," we think. We take down our Christmas lights, drag the tree out onto the curb, and return to our everyday lives. But in truth the celebration is only just beginning! The carols, the feasting, the lights, the joy, have only just commenced. There is a reason why Christmas is called a season. It does not last for a single day. the Christmas season (also known as Christmastide) lasts 40 days. It begins with the vigil Mass said on Christmas Eve, and ends on February 2nd, Candlemas, which is the day on which we celebrate the feast of Jesus' presentation in the temple. Wishing you all a very happy, holy and peaceful Christmastide.
