THIS WEEK WE CELEBRATE THE MEMORIALS OF ST FRANCIS DE SALES AND ST AGNES

ST FRANCIS DE SALES: Francis was sent to Padua to study law by his father who wanted him to become a lawyer. He received his qualification but on returning home informed his father that he wanted to become a priest. His father opposed this idea and it took all Francis' powers of persuasion to convince his father. Francis was ordained and at the age of 35 became Bishop of Geneva. He was a gentle man who when evangelising practiced his own saying of ““A spoonful of honey attracts more flies than a barrelful of vinegar.” His meekness and joyful disposition won for him the title of “Gentleman Saint.”

ST AGNES: Born in 291AD to a wealthy family was very beautiful and had many high ranking suitors. Although Agnes made a promise to God to remain a virgin, whenever she received a proposal of marriage she would say “Jesus Christ is my only spouse.” An angry suitor the governors son reported her to the governor when she spurned him accusing her of being a Christian a title she never denied, she was condemned to death by the Governor and martyred by the sword.
