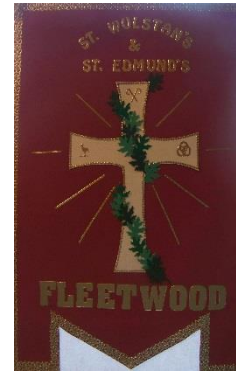


## Repeats
