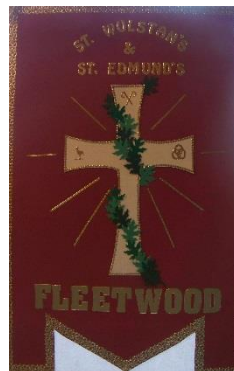

Assumption of The BVM: Wednesday 15th August is the Solemn Feast of Our Lady's Assumption into Heaven, and is a Holy Day of Obligation. Mass will be 12 noon at St Wulstan's and 7pm at St Edmund's to celebrate this great feast.

On the Beach? If the beautiful sunny weather holds up, we will be having a parish picnic, to be held at the two beach huts nearest the old pier site, Sunday 19th August from 2pm. The Jags will be playing some of their "greatest hits" and all are welcome. It will not be a fund-raiser, merely an opportunity to enjoy ourselves as a parish community. If it is raining, the event will not take place, as the Band members, not being good conductors of electricity, are reluctant to be electrocuted. If you'd like to make a few cakes, or sandwiches etc, you would be most welcome.

The Blessed Sacrament: As mentioned on Sunday, we are now on the countdown to the Eucharistic Congress, taking place in Liverpool 7-9th September, which aims to put adoration of Our Lord in the Blessed Sacrament back at centre stage in Catholic Life. With that in mind, two parishioners have asked me to make an appeal on behalf of people who want some quiet time with Our Lord before Mass begins. The appeal is to keep the noise down by greeting friends in a quiet voice, or even a whisper, so that those trying to pray are not overly disturbed. An idea some of us picked up from a conference, was to have a proper 'meet and greet' session after the opening hymn, so that everyone's involved. What do you think? I've tried it with the whole school Mass, and it worked pretty well.
