

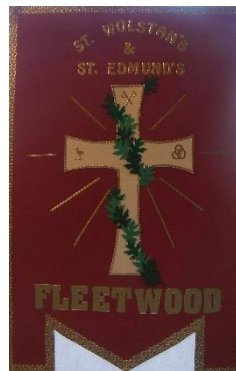
Glory Bees: We've had a great crop of honey this year, thanks to our Glory Bees and a lovely summer. Will be on sale at the Christmas Fayre.

Good News from SPUC: I am delighted to let you know that the Home Secretary has made his long awaited announcement on buffer zones. He said that it would 'not be a proportionate response' to introduce national buffer zones. This is a great victory for common sense, democracy and above all for the hundreds of vulnerable women who are saved from the horror of abortion at the very gates of the abortion clinic. The postcards sent to the Home Secretary in the last two weeks have clearly had an impact. Throughout SPUC's campaign to protect pro-life vigils our chief motivation has always been the mothers who need help, even as they are walking into the abortion clinic, and the many babies and children alive today because of an encounter with a pro-life citizen.
