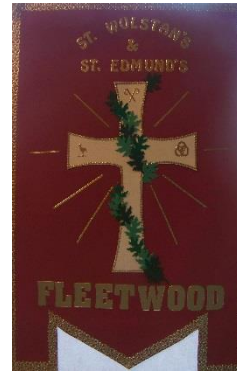

A Request: The Sisters of the Cross and Passion, based in Lytham have written the following to us:-

Dear Reverend Canon,

As you know, the Sisters of the Cross and Passion first came to the Fylde Coast, at St Peter's, Lytham, in 1873. That was only nine years after the death of the Foundress, the Servant of God, Mother Mary Joseph of Jesus (Elizabeth Prout) and also her co-Founders, the Servant of God, Father Ignatius Spencer CP, the great friend of Blessed Dominic Barberi CP. All three Causes for Canonization are currently under scrutiny by the Holy See and we are hoping that in early 2019 Elizabeth Prout may be declared 'Venerable'.

As our Congregation has been closely connected with your parish or neighbourhood for many years, we should like to ask you a favour: please will you also pray for this intention and ask your parishioners and friends to do the same?

If any people receive favours, or miracles, through her intercession, I should be most grateful if they would forward an accurate account with any necessary documentation to me, so that I can then forward this material to the Vice-Postulator, Father Paul Francis Spencer CP, for him to pass on to the Passionist Postulator General in Rome and he to the Holy See. Asking your Blessing on this work, Canon.

Sister Dominic has also sent us some prayer cards and CTS booklets which you can pick up from the back, and a 10 page history of what Fleetwood and Cleveleys owes to the Foundress, Mother Mary Joseph of Jesus, which you are welcome to borrow.
