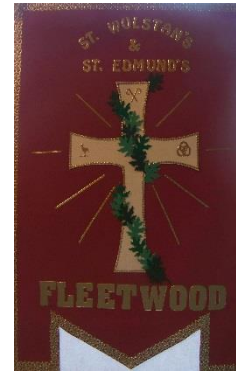
Christmas Mass Times:
