

<u>Stepping Stones:</u> Is a bereavement support group, supported by Trinity Hospice. We used to run it from St Edmund's, but it fizzled out due to lack of use. However, there are groups throughout the Fylde, a list of which is at the back of church. Fleetwood's group is now at the Baptist Church, Poulton Road on the  $4^{th}$  Sunday of the month from 5-6pm.

<u>Community Sponsorship Scheme:</u> This Government programme, introduced in the UK in 2016 is a way for civil society groups to play a greater role in resettling the most vulnerable refugees, fleeing persecution in their own countries. Caritas Catholic Social Action Network is helping parishes to respond to Pope Francis' call to welcome refugees, and Sean Ryan MBE, the National Caritas Co-ordinator will tell us something about it next week.

<u>Student Cross 12-21<sup>st</sup> April:</u> Is an annual pilgrimage to Walsingham in which students, and anyone else who'd like to join them, carry a large cross from 11 different starting points, during Holy Week, ending with the celebration of Easter.
