

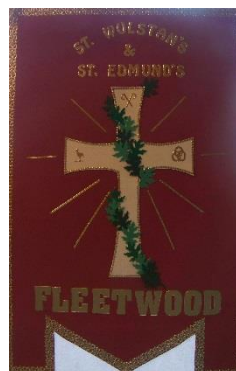

Apocalypse Now? Climate Change: What we must do: 6th July, 10am till 4pm, at LACE, Croxteth Drive, Liverpool, L17 1AA. The programme includes: Dr Paul Rooney, from Liverpool Hope University, who will talk about The Reality and Urgency of Climate Change action. Bishop John Arnold, Bishop of Salford, who will talk about Addressing the theological imperatives of Climate Change. Jo Musker-Sherwood Director, Hope for the Future - an organisation working to equip communities, campaigners and groups across the country to communicate the urgency of climate change. Jo will address our need for Action: from the personal to the collective. Everyone is welcome to attend, lunch is included in the day. A donation of £10 is suggested.

Ordination to Priesthood: Deacon Stephen Talbot will be ordained to the Priesthood on Saturday 6th July at 11.30 in the Cathedral. This is a great and joyous occasion for our Diocese as there are so few men coming forward for ordination these days.
