

**Deepening Catholic Reflection on Scripture:** Pope Francis is urging Catholics to deepen their relationship with the Bible and has announced that one Sunday each year will be dedicated to breaking open the Scriptures. Writing in an apostolic letter, Francis has announced that the Third Sunday in Ordinary Time, which occurs at the end of January, will be "devoted to the celebration, study and dissemination of the Word of God". This is a day, the Pope says, for parishes to focus on the importance of Scripture and for priests to hand out Bibles to each member of the congregation.

It is true that most Catholics rely on Sunday Mass for their weekly diet of Scripture, rather than feeding daily on the feast of delights that reside in the Bible. I am very happy to follow Pope Francis' request to hand out Bibles to anyone in the Parish who doesn't have one. If you'd like one, put your name on the list at the back of church. (Say if you need a large print edition). We spend a lot of money on our buildings and maintenance, which is right and proper, but surely it's more important to build up "The Living Stones of the Temple" which are you and me. For those who prefer to have the Bible on their ipad, mobile phone or computer etc go to Bible.com or You Version where you can download it for free. So far 394 million people have downloaded the App. I suggest the Jerusalem Bible or the RSV, as they are the ones we're most used to. There's also a Bible App for kids. As St Jerome, who in the early days of the Church, translated the Bible into Latin, says "Ignorance of Scripture is Ignorance of Christ".
