

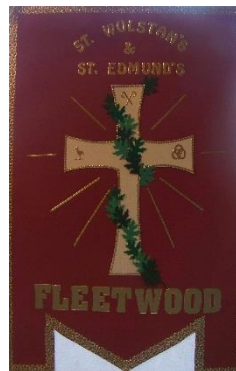
Repeats
