"When you enter this church it may be possibly that you hear the 'call of God'. However, it is unlikely that He will call you on your mobile. Thank you for turning off your phone. If you want to talk to God, enter, choose a quiet place and talk to him. If you want to see HIM, send him a text while driving."


