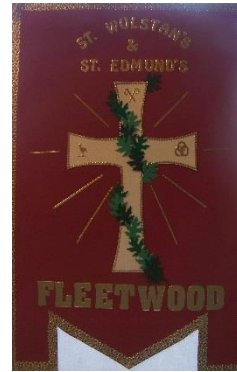

A Note from the Police - Track and Trace Scams: There are a number of Track and Trace scams in existence, often with bogus callers asking for all kinds of personal details, or wanting to charge people for a testing kit. You might like to include the following in a parish newsletter: Fake callers contact someone saying they are from NHS Track & Trace, telling them that they have been in contact with someone suffering from Covid-19 and need to have a test sent out to them. This is swiftly followed with a request for the resident's bank details; the caller states that the test must be paid-for. Please do not fall for this scam. If you need a test sent out to you because you are unable to attend a test site, this is done for free, both delivery and collection, followed up by the result. The NHS Test and Trace service will NOT:

- ask for bank details or payments
- ask for details of any other accounts, such as social media
- ask you to set up a password or PIN number over the phone
- ask you to call a premium rate number, such as those starting 09 or 087
- ask you to download a link from your mobile
- ask you to divulge lots of personal information

Marriage Care - we're still here to help couples: Relationships are hard to do at the best of times, but right now, families are having to juggle so many new problems - home schooling, job losses and more. Marriage Care continues to offer Relationship Counselling via online web cam 'face to face' services e.g. Zoom.
