

<u>The Pantry:</u> As we come to the end of the first week in our new premises in the old hospital, I'm pleased to be able to report that things have gone pretty well. Obviously, we are still ironing out some of the problems of adapting to new circumstances, but so far, so good. In the mornings we still take out food to those who, for one reason or another, can't get to the Pantry, then in the afternoons, individuals come to collect their food at a pre-arranged time. Here Comes JETS: Some useful information via Healthier Fleetwood for people looking for work. "As announced in the Chancellor's July mini-budget, there is a need to help people who lost their jobs due to the current pandemic to get back into work, and therefore our new programme, Job Entry Targeted Support (JETS NW) has been created to support this priority. We expect to help over 24,000 unemployed people across the NW over the next 12 months, with the first referrals starting Monday 5<sup>th</sup> October. We'll be supporting and helping people in Cheshire, Merseyside, Lancashire and Cumbria. Who is it for? JETS NW is for unemployed people who have been claiming work-related benefits for at least 13 weeks, who would benefit from some additional help to find work as soon as possible. It is for all people of working age. All referrals come through Job Centre Plus Work Coaches. JETS NW provides each participant with a dedicated Employment Coach who will help them navigate and access a range of support from our internal teams and external partners. All they need to do is speak to their Job Centre Plus Work Coach and get them to refer them to Ingeus Job Entry Targeted Support (JETS NW) scheme.
