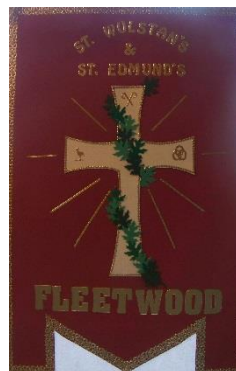

Latest Covid Guidance from the Bishops' Conference: You can read the new information on the CBCEW website, but the main points affecting us in Stage 3 are:

1. The 30 person rule at funerals is dropped in favour of church's safety capacity.
2. The Offertory procession can take place.
3. Weddings and Standalone Baptisms can take place with up to 30 people.
4. Holy Communion can be taken to the housebound.
5. Face coverings remain a legal requirement until further notice.
6. Singing, the kiss of peace, and communion under both kinds are still not allowed. zx

There are another few minor things that have been relaxed, but as we are advised to take into account local conditions, especially the 'Indian variant' which is causing concern in the North West at the moment, I think it would be prudent to wait a little longer.

Diocesan Pilgrimage to Lourdes: You may have learned recently that our pilgrimage travel operator, Joe Walsh Pilgrim Tours Ltd, has ceased trading and, unfortunately, gone into receivership. When I have details of the refund process I will personally be in touch with all pilgrims who have made payments. I am informed that the claims for UK pilgrimages will begin this coming week via a Claim's Manager, who is already in receipt of all the Lancaster bookings. Every pilgrim will be written to or e-mailed with an explanatory letter and claims form. A portal will also be opened online for the claims process. There will be a 9 month period in which UK pilgrims can claim. The pilgrimage planning committee will look at travel options for the next pilgrimage.
