

HEALTHIER FLEETWOOD NEWS - COMMUNITY CAFÉ AT 'THE HUB':

We regularly update on all the Good News coming out of The Hub, the former Fleetwood Hospital building, and as the next exciting phase of the development, applications are open to operate the venue's Community Cafe. Fleetwood Trust are the owners of the building, and their CEO Charley Wilkinson says, "We are seeking a social enterprise or charity, whose values align to ours, who would be interested in operating the new facility. It would suit someone who is socially minded, with an entrepreneurial spirit and puts people and community at the heart of their decision making. Also, a creative programme of volunteering would be an advantage". From stakeholder discussions in 2019 and 2023 it was identified that the cafe should be an 'energetic and active place in the community' and the time has come for us to make that vision a reality and bring to life the beating heart of our Hub."

The cafe is located on the ground floor inside the Hub, is currently being renovated and will complete the ground floor, already occupied by a wide range of services and organisations including Regenda Homes, Fylde Coast Macmillan Information and Support Service, Blackpool and The Fylde College, Fleetwood Town Community Trust, Fleetwood Youth Hub, Counselling in the Community Charity and NHS Outpatients along with the ambulance service - all of whom bring a significant amount of daily footfall to The Hub.
