- The Christmas Draw tickets are available from the back of church. There is also a list of Draw Prizes at the back of church, for those who would like to donate a prize.

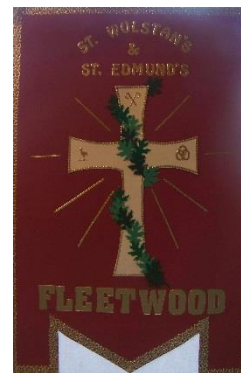
