Ahead of the schools breaking up for Christmas, bookings for the Winter Holiday Activities and Food clubs with Wyre Council are now open. Funded by the Department for Education, holiday club places in Wyre are available free to children and young people who receive benefits-related free school meals in the summer, Easter and Christmas holidays. There are also paid-for places available for families that are not eligible to attend for free. If your child is eligible to take part, you should have received a text or email with your code and instructions about how to book. The booking system has changed, and the advice is to give yourself some extra time to familiarise with the new system.
