The three-day pilgrimage will take in Holy Island and Bamburgh and Durham Cathedral, and we will be staying at the historic former seminary of the North of England, Ushaw College. The cost of the pilgrimage is £310 for shared accommodation and £340 for single rooms, all inclusive, with coach pick-ups at Workington and Carlisle. JUBILEE PILGRIMAGE TO WALSINGHAM - BISHOP PAUL

In this Jubilee Year our annual Diocesan Pilgrimage to Walsingham, the National Shrine to Our Blessed Lady, will take place 20-24 October 2025. I invite you to join me! A Jubilee Year is a moment of grace in the life of the Church. The practice finds its roots in the Old Testament covenant made between God and his people, Israel. It was a time of redemption, a moment when land and property were returned to their original owners and slaves were set free (Leviticus 25). In Luke's Gospel it is no small thing that Jesus' first public proclamation, which took place in the Synagogue in Nazareth, recalls the prophetic words of Isaiah with the promise of a "year of favour from the Lord" (Is 61:1-2). Our pilgrimage to Walsingham is therefore an excellent way to mark this time of grace, both as a diocese and individually. The all-inclusive cost is £475.00-£550.00 (dependent on accommodation type). Coach collection/dropoff will take place in Workington, Carlisle, Penrith, Lancaster and Preston. PS FROM BRIAN WOOD: In the mid-90's, my colleague visited HMP Long Lartin in Worcestershire to interview four men. She set off very early, arriving just before 10 o'clock. She went into the prison visiting room and asked to see Mr Robinson. The Officer in charge said "Ah, he was taken seriously ill yesterday so he's not here. Who's next?" Ann said "Mr. Smith." The Officer said "He assaulted an Officer yesterday and is awaiting a Governor's adjudication. Who's next?" Ann said "Mr Brown." The officer said "He was transferred to HMP Gartree yesterday. Who's left?" Ann said "Mr Bloggs." "Yes" the Officer said, "He's here. He shouted his name and a man came from the waiting room. He went up to Ann and asked "Who are you?" Ann introduced herself, saying "I'm your Probation Officer." He then told her to go away in no uncertain terms and walked away. Ann was back in the car park by ten past ten. What a productive morning! As Ann said later " At least I had a pleasant drive around the Vale of Evesham!" <u>ASSISTED SUICIDE BILL</u> - message from Fr Alf. With Fr Stephen's approval, I have written to our MP asking for an hour of her time to discuss with us the above, before the next reading. So far, she has not replied. This is the fourth time I have written to her, and have had only one reply, which was a standardised general reply. However, as this issue is such an important and fundamental one for future legislation, it would still be good to have a meeting to examine in more detail, what is being proposed, so that we have a clearer idea of what our Representatives are signing up to, and what we might do if we're not happy with their decisions.
