RITE OF CHRISTIAN INITIATION OF ADULTS (RCIA):

In September we will be starting a new course for those wishing to become Catholic. If you are interested or know of anyone who would like to explore what it is to be a Roman Catholic Christian, please speak to Fr Stephen to register.

MOVING FORWARD: At our last Deanery Conference many issues came up about the reality of where we are today - lack of priests, empty church buildings, merging of parishes etc, all the things people have been talking about for some time. As a Deanery, we decided to do something about it, rather than wait to see what happens. The result was for each priest to hold three openended parish meetings, in which everyone has the opportunity to put their thoughts and ideas forward, followed by a full Deanery meeting, open to everyone, on 15th November, facilitated by Dr Vron Smith from the Jesuit Institute, Hexham and Newcastle, with whom Fr Peter Sharrock, our Dean, Sr Philomena and Fr Alf met recently. St John's Poulton and Guardian Angels, Blackpool, have already begun. This Sunday, at Mass, in our own parishes, Fr Alf will give the talk he gave at Guardian Angels, as a background to initiate the conversation. Each priest has been provided with relevant bullet points for the parish discussions. Notes will be taken in each parish and forwarded to Dr Smith in preparation for the big meeting in November. Hopefully, as many parishioners as possible will come to the meetings and lend their fruitful ideas for the way ahead. Details of meetings to follow.
