ST MARYS PRESBYTERY UPDATE: As you will be aware St Mary's Presbytery has been unoccupied for over a year now, this is obviously not good for the fabric of the building as well as the financial burden to the parish of maintenance, heating and upkeep of an empty building. After consultation with the parish council and the diocese it has been decided that it will be a cost-effective solution to rent the presbytery as a family house. This will provide a steady stream of income for the parish whose financial outgoings are currently greater than the income we receive from our weekly collection. The presbytery will need to have some remedial renovation work undertaken to make it fit to rent. We will also be emptying the house of furniture and decorations which will be offered in the first instance to the parish for donation.
