NEWS FROM HEALTHIER FLEETWOOD There's a series of FREE NHS health checks arranged for Fleetwood over the next couple of months, supported by Fleetwood Primary Care Network. Drop-in to see the staff from Fylde Coast Medical Services on the 'health bus' at several locations across the Town. They will carry out a blood pressure check and look for early signs of conditions such as stroke, heart disease, type 2 diabetes and dementia: - Thursday 27th November, 9am - 4pm at Strive Community Cafe, Northfleet Ave. - Thursday 11th December, 10am - 4pm at The HUB Fleetwood, North Albert St. - Saturday 20th December, 12noon - 3pm, Fleetwood Town FC, Highbury Stadium. The health checks are open to anyone aged 40 - 74 without pre-existing medical conditions. There's no need to pre-book for these AND you can also pick up a voucher for FREE coffee & cake at The HUB / Strive events - redeemable on the day at the cafes. The health check bus is also at Affinity Lancashire Outlet on Sunday 9th November from 10am to 4pm ... > this session does require pre-booking here
