RIGHT OF CHRISTIAN INITIATION OF CHILDREN:

In the next few weeks we will be starting a programme for any children between 7 and 11 years old who have not yet been baptised. In Canon law once a child has reached the age of reason (7 years old) they cannot be baptised purely with the request of the parent, the child must make the decision for themselves. In order for them to make this decision they are required to be instructed in the faith. We currently have a number of young people about to start this preparation. If you are aware of any other candidates for this course please ask the parent to contact Fr Stephen in the next week to enrol on the program.

THE SEASON OF CHRISTMASTIDE: For most people Christmas ends at midnight on Christmas day. But for the Catholic Church, it means the celebration has just begun. Many of us Catholics, however, are not aware of this. Our rhythm of celebrating Christmas is very much along the lines of the secular celebration. We put a massive amount of effort into preparing for December 25th...then, the very next day, we feel a bit blue. "It's over," we think. We take down our Christmas lights, drag the tree out onto the curb, and return to our everyday lives. But in truth the celebration is only just beginning! The carols, the feasting, the lights, the joy, have only just commenced. There is a reason why Christmas is called a season. It does not last for a single day. the Christmas season (also known as Christmastide) lasts 40 days. It begins with the vigil Mass said on Christmas Eve, and ends on February 2nd, Candlemas, which is the day on which we celebrate the feast of Jesus' presentation in the temple.
